
**Government Order No. 449(JK) HME of 2021  
Dated 17-06-2021**

Sanction is hereby accorded to the grant of provisional "No Objection Certificate" (NOC) in favour of M/s S.V.S Para Medical College, Shiv Kashi, Sunderbani, Rajouri, for starting B. Pharmacy Course subject to the condition that the institution fulfills the conditions prescribed by the Apex body i.e. Pharmacy Council of India for imparting training courses in Pharmacy as per Pharmacy Education Regulations in vogue.

This provisional NOC shall be however, further based on the following stipulations :-

- (i) Subject to the fulfillment of provisions laid down in the Central Pharmacy Council Act, 1948
- (ii) No admission fee will be charged
- (ii) The permission shall be subject to any policy on the subject which the Government may sanction in future for regulation of the institutes
- (iii) Eligibility of candidates for admission to the courses shall be made on merit basis as per the provisions laid down by the Government from time to time through J&K Board of Professional Entrance Examinations
- (iv) The J&K Pharmacy Council shall conduct inspection of the institute, periodically, to monitor and assess the adequacy of infrastructure in relation to the number of trainees
- (v) An amount of Rs. 5000/- per trainee per session be charged by the Institute on account of providing hospital facility, and the amount so received be utilized for Hospital development fund of the Hospital, to which the institute is attached for practical training.

- (vi) For any lapse on the part of any student/students resulting in loss/damage to equipment/chemicals etc. in the Hospital, the institute shall be responsible for it. An undertaking to this effect be executed by the management of the institution with the Medical Superintendent of the Hospital,
- (vii) The J&K Pharmacy Council shall conduct examination of the trainees.




